



## Thailand Inter-School Sailing Championship 2017

14 - 15 January at the Royal Varuna Yacht Club

### Notice of Race

#### 1) INTRODUCTION

a. The event is for school teams, using two person boats 'RS QUBAS' as supplied by the organising authority, racing in team-racing format (three boat team racing).

#### 2) ORGANISING AUTHORITY

a. The event is organised by the Royal Varuna Yacht Club, under the auspices of the Yacht Racing Association of Thailand.

#### 3) RULES

a. The event will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing including appendix D Team Racing Rules, and the Sailing Instructions available on the day of the event, and this Notice of Race.

b. Races will be umpired.

#### 4) ENTRIES

a. The event is open to school teams based in Thailand.

b. Sailors in each school team shall be 18 years or under. They must be students at their representing school.

c. Each team must have a minimum of six sailors with all team members declared at registration. Reserve sailors are allowed and recommended but must be declared at registration. Only six sailors can sail in each race (3 helms and 3 crews). Team members swapping between races is permitted.

d. The entry fee is 750 baht per competitor.

#### 5) EVENT FORMAT AND SCHEDULE

Saturday 14 January	
9.30am	Main competitors briefing, all must attend.
10.30am	First team-race in the round robin series
5.30pm	No race shall start after this time
6pm	BBQ on beach (free for all competitors)
Sunday 15 January	
9.30am	Main competitors briefing, all must attend.
10.30am	First team-race of the day.
3pm	No race shall start after this time
3.30pm	Prize giving

The racing format will be round-robin races with the school team(s) achieving the most number of wins going into the next rounds. The exact format will be published in the sailing instructions available at registration.

#### 6) PERSONAL BUOYANCY

a. A personal floatation device must be worn at all times when afloat

#### 7) DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

a. Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone". Sailing by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in this event, each competitors agrees and acknowledges that they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves and their crew to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event. They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions.

#### 8) PRIZES

a. The winning school will receive the Inter-School champions trophy. All other prizes are at discretion of the organising authority.
